## Legislative Achievements

### 2020

**HB 175 Housing Discrimination:** People who claim housing discrimination based on race, religion, national origin, sex, handicap or family status will no longer have to wait prior to seeking civil action. **Enrolled.**

**HB 199 Sexual Battery Prosecution Time Limitation “Donna’s Law”:** Removes restrictions for prosecution of sexual battery involving victim younger than 18 at the time offense is committed. **Signed into Law.**

**Expansion of READ USA Book Fairs:** Expansion of book fairs to increase reading skills amongst 3<sup>rd</sup> graders. **\$100,000**

**Agape (Mobile Dental Unit):** Provides dental services for underserved populations. **\$750,000**

**Keep Florida Beautiful:** Cleanup and litter prevention programs. **\$800,000**

**Florida Children's Initiative (FCI):** Community-based service network that provides quality education, accessible health care, youth development programs, opportunities for employment, and safe and affordable housing for children and families. **\$250,000**

**Edward Waters College - Online Degree Program:** Provides for online degrees. **\$100,000**

## 2019

**HB 43 Transportation Facility Designations:** Portion of highway named after fallen Officer Lance Christian Whitaker in Duval County. **Signed into law (SB 64)**

**HB 327 Pub. Meetings/Pub. Records/Local Government Utilities:** Protects local government utility information, networks, computers, and data from hackers. **Signed into law.**

**HB 591 Pub. Rec./Public Utility Held Customer Information and Data:** Protects customer meter data and billing information from public records. **Signed into law.**

**Keep Florida Beautiful:** Cleanup and litter prevention programs. **\$800,000**

**Edward Waters College - Pre-College Academy (Summer Bridge):** Gives 100 selected students the opportunity to get an early start by earning 9-credit hours prior to the start of their first college semester in the fall. **\$100,000**

**Florida Children's Initiative:** Community-based service network that provides quality education, accessible health care, youth development programs, opportunities for employment, and safe and affordable housing for children and families. **\$500,000**

## 2018

**HB 609 Vote-by-Mail Ballots:** Allows supervisor of elections to accept an elector's voted vote-by-mail ballot at an early voting site in the county where the elector is registered to vote. **Passed on House Floor**

**HB 853 Housing Discrimination:** People who claim housing discrimination based on race, religion, national origin, sex, handicap or family status will no longer have to wait prior to seeking civil action. **Passed on House Floor.**

**HB 7011 OGSR/School Food and Nutrition Service Program:** Protects personal identifying information of applicants and participants in school food & nutrition service program; **Signed into law.**

**HB 7077 OGSR/Agency Employee Misconduct Complaint:** Protects public records for complaint of misconduct against agency employee until investigation ends. **Signed into law.**

**HB 2745 McCoy's Creek Boulevard Project:** Lessens/mitigates flooding in the area by making road improvements. **\$200,000**

**HB 3695 Edward Waters College - College Promise Program:** Creates a pathway for lowincome first time college students. **\$356,000**

## 2017

**HR 1335 Arthur G. Dozier School for Boys:** Acknowledging the abuses experienced by children confined in the Arthur G. Dozier School for Boys and expressing the Legislature's regret for such abuses and the commitment to ensure that the children of the State of Florida are protected from the abuses and violations that took place at such facility. **Adopted by the House.**

**HB 1293 City of Jacksonville, Duval County** Provides special restaurant beverage licenses for restaurants in designated zone. **Signed into law.**

**HB 1291 City of Jacksonville, Duval County J-3:** Permitting businesses located in the Stadium District to sell alcoholic beverages to patrons. **Signed into law.**

**HB 7087 OGSR/Protective Injunctions for Certain Types of Violence:** Protects personal identifying & location information of person requesting protection against domestic violence, repeat violence, sexual violence, & dating violence. **Signed into law.**

**HB 521 Vote-by-Mail Ballots:** Authorizes absent elector to personally deliver his or her vote-by-mail ballot to early voting site.  
**Passed on House Floor.**

**HB 1139 Minority Teacher Education Scholars:** Eases requirements for minority teacher education scholarship award. **Passed on House Floor** (language in HB 7069).

**HB 231 Nonpartisan Elections for State Attorneys and Public Defenders:** Would make state attorneys and public defenders elections nonpartisan, it would also eliminate a write-in candidate loophole. **(Died in committee).**

**HB 2439 J.P. Small Park Museum Improvements:** Improvements to the Negro League Museum, Fitness Center, Lighting, etc. **\$500,000**

**HB 3123 Lift Ev'ry Voice and Sing Park (James Weldon Johnson and Rosamond Johnson Birthplace Project):** Establishes a park to recognize two nationally known historical figures. **\$50,000**

**HB 3125 Florida Children Initiative (FCI):** Community-based service network that provides quality education, accessible health care, youth development programs, opportunities for employment, and safe and affordable housing for children and families. **\$600,000**
